

Drawing Class Materials List

For this Drawing Class, students are required to bring...

- Yourself and your interest in drawing!
- A Drawing Pad (11 x 14" 80lb. weight or higher)
- An old shirt or smock to protect your clothes

What should you look for in a Drawing Pad?

Type- Make sure your drawing pad says "Drawing"; It is commonly used for sketching and finished work. Drawing paper is heavier, has a slightly textured surface, and allows more working with the paper. Do not buy smooth-surfaced pads. The ideal mediums used with drawing paper are dry; graphite pencils and sticks, charcoal pencils compressed charcoal sticks, and vine charcoal among others.

Size- Drawing pads come in a wide range of sizes. 11" x 14" will accommodate your drawing needs!

Weight- A heavier weight paper can handle more layering, and various techniques, than a lighter weight paper.. The weight of the paper is not determined by the individual sheet but is determined by a ream of 500 sheets weighed together at the factory.
